What We Look For in Freshman Applicants

Virginia Tech takes a holistic approach to reviewing applications, which means we review the whole applicant - you're not just a GPA. The most important factors are your strength of curriculm, grades, and standardized test courses.

Transfer Applicants

Transfer applicants are reviewed based on completion or substantial progress toward completing prequisite courses and overall GPA in college coursework. Competitive applicants will have a 3.0 GPA or better. We strongly encourage transfer applicants to contact our office and work with an admissions director as early as possible before applying.
